Thanks to all of you who prayed for Open Eyes Ministries and our needs on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. It was a day of seeking God's direction for us and we believe He revealed many things to us. Your e-mails and comments are greatly appreciated and we ask that you continue to lift us up whenever you have time.

Many blessings continue in Central America. To share a few; we were able to purchase a new truck for the ministry to replace the one I drove from the USA 7 years ago. It is a Toyota Hilux, 4 door pick up and again we thank all of you who helped us with the finances. Since I have begun to travel to all three countries; Honduras, Nicaragua, and Costa Rica it will be the reliable transportation I need.

Also, in the last week of August, OEM and JAM were present at the dedication of the new chapel and new wall at the Central Prison in Choluteca, Honduras. JAM has designated over \$30,000 the last few years to build the facilities and many people were present at the celebration including, TV and radio, the mayor and dignitaries of Choluteca, police commissioner and prison officials. Jeff Andler brought a message, praise and worship was uplifting and lunch was provided for all. Many prisoners, guards, and family members have been saved in this work and cell groups are ongoing and provided by local pastors and churches.

Please pray for "Norma", a four year old child from El Triunfo, Honduras who has a heart defect and needs an operation soon. During a medical mission team in that city in July with Trinity Baptist Church they met Norma and she became a matter of prayer for that surgery and her healing. Now through the efforts of Dr. Holston, who was on the trip, we are preparing to send her to the USA as soon as the paperwork and logistics can be worked out through Helping Hands Honduras. God is good.

I have just returned to Honduras after a week in Costa Rica and also a week in Nicaragua working with our zone pastors in different areas, preaching, teaching, and sharing the vision of OEM. We spent time in Nicaragua in Leon, Matagalpa, Managua, San Marcos, and Masaya and in Costa Rica in Sardinal, Liberia, Santo Cruz and Cañas where we did a three day leadership conference. OEM's vision continues to open up areas to provide ministry and see lives changed.

This month, September, will see us building a pastor's home in Honduras and doing evangelism in Costa Rica followed in October by another team in Costa Rica, a crusade in Nicaragua and evangelism in Honduras. October 26<sup>th</sup> will mark the beginning of our 8<sup>th</sup> year in Central America and we will celebrate with each of you with a special anniversary issue of the OEM newsletter. May God continue to bless you so you can bless us and we can bless others.
